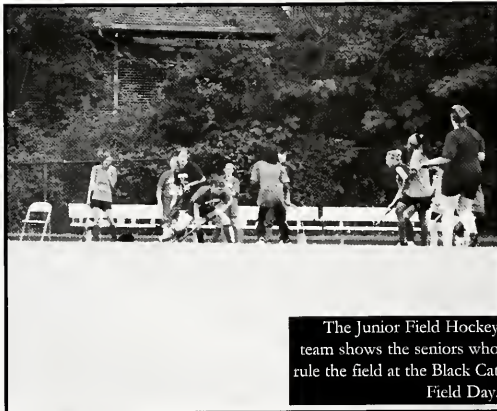

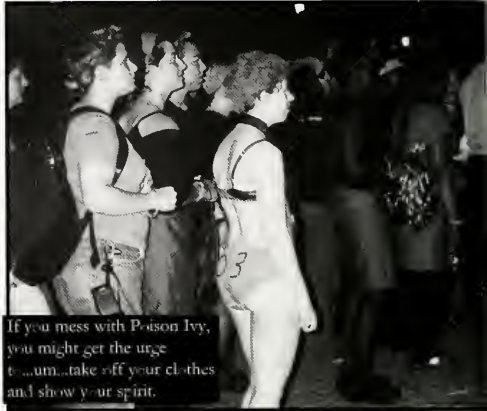

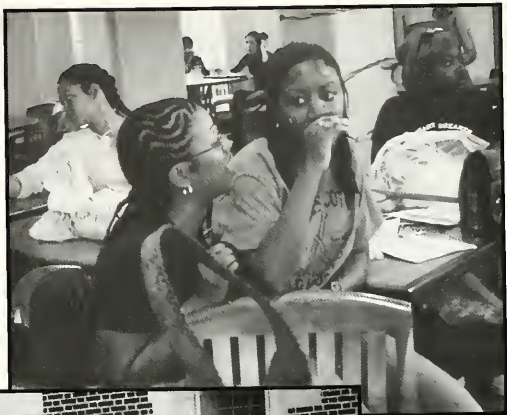

Orientation Week 2001

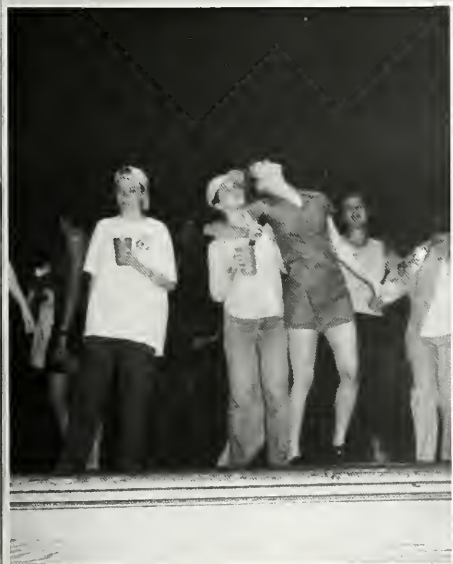

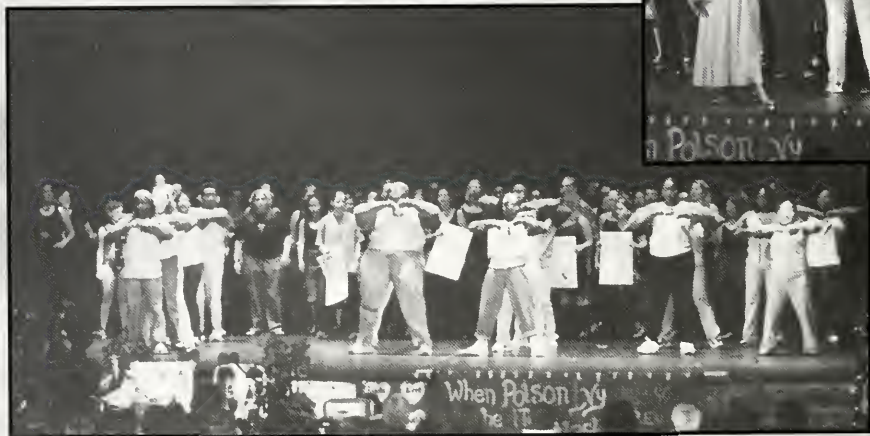




Green with Envy

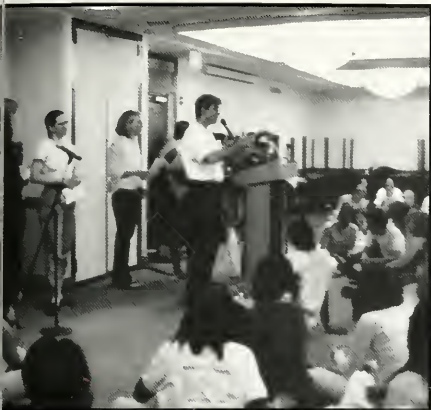

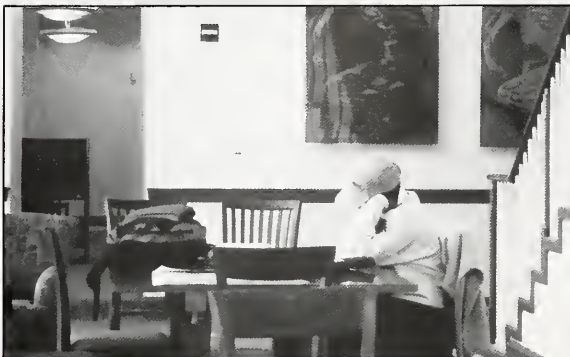
