




POEMAO F

June 28, 1969 marks what most think of as the start of Pride, but in reality was a violent riot between the New York City Police and the patrons of Stonewall Inn. Marsha Pay It No Mind Johnson, a black trans woman, threw the first brick at the police as they illegally raided the bar as homosexuality was illegal at this time. While Pride now brings forth images of rainbows and celebration, it is vital we remember that trans women of color are the foundations of what was, and still is, an act of resistance for living authentically.
