Mr. John Adams, a member of the Department of Music at Agnes Scott College, will present a concert of violin music on December 5 at 8:15 P. M. in Maclean Auditorium on campus.

Now in his fifteenth year at Agnes Scott, Mr. Adams is a graduate of the Eastman School of Music. He has played with the Rochester Philharmonic Orchestra, and currently is a member of the Atlanta Symphony and Chamber Orchestra.

The program will open with the Sonata in C Major, Opus 5, No. III by Arcangelo Corelli, a work considered a model for other musicians of Corelli's time. Following this, Mr. Adams will perform a Mendelssohn concerto quite popular several decades ago, but rarely heard today in concert, the Concerto in E Minor, Opus 64. He will conclude with Cesar Franck's Sonata in A Major, a late work of the French master.

Assisting Mr. Adams in the program will be Mr. Michael McDowell, pianist.

The public is cordially invited to attend. There will be no charge.
